### September

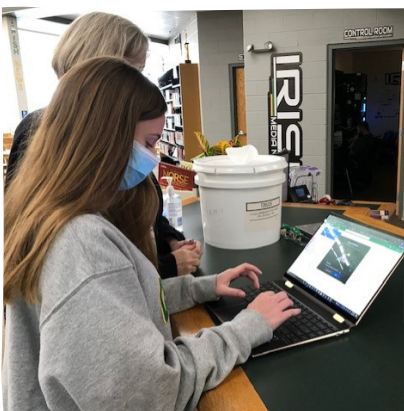
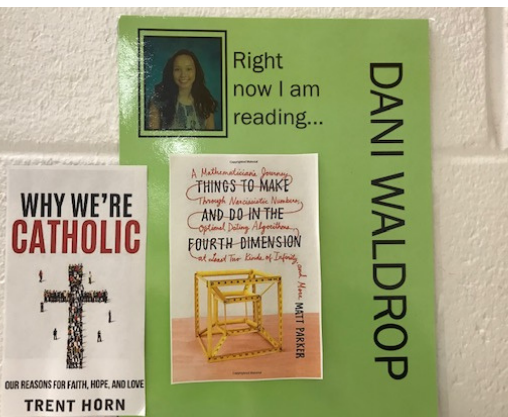
#### 20th anniversary of 9/11

Display highlighted the rich heritage and contributions of Hispanic Americans.



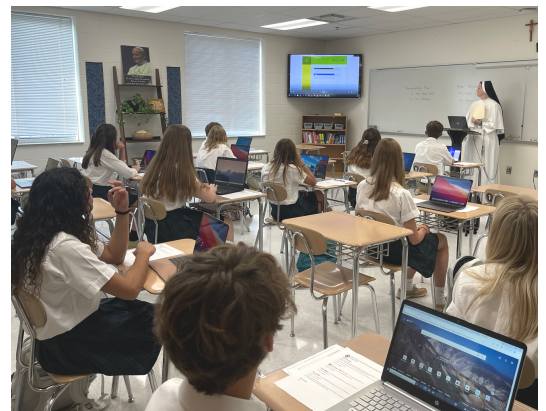
## TECH HELP
