Class of 2026—Important Senior Picture Information

- Senior photos will be July 7-8 in the auditorium at KCHS.
 - You will receive an appointment via email from Big Orange Professional Photography (BOPP) in June.
- Last make-up date will be August 8 during the afternoon/evening.

Appointments will be made **by students after school starts**. It is strongly recommended that you go to one of the summer dates so that you still have an opportunity for retakes if something goes wrong with the first round.

- Sitting fee is \$35 and payable on the day photos are taken (checks to BOPP, credit/debit cards and Venmo also available). If you do have retakes, there is an additional sitting fee of \$35, unless there was a photographer error. "Yearbook only" clients, who choose not to pay the sitting fee, are photographed with one image in the tux or drape and do not receive cap & gown pose.
 - **Grooming**: In order for the formal portrait to be used in the yearbook, school guidelines for grooming must be observed. Guys, please make sure that your **hair is not in your eyes**, that you are **clean shaven** and **no ear piercings**. Guys and girls, **no nose piercings** and you may want to bring a friend or family member to help with hair, etc. Also, due to time constraints, the photos that are printed in the yearbook are not retouched. Girls, **tan lines are especially obvious**, so you may want to take care of that prior to your photo.
 - You **MUST** have the formal portrait made with the school photographer to be included in the yearbook.
 - There are **four photo settings**: formal, indoor casual, outdoor, and cap & gown. You may bring two changes of clothing and any props you choose (e.g., guitar, football, etc.) for the indoor casual and outdoor settings. The tux & drape and the cap, gown, and National Honor Society stole (if applicable) are provided by the photography company. **Gender specific formal attire must be worn for the yearbook portrait**. Please ask for the stole if you are in NHS.
 - **Proofs**: Except for cap & gown, proofs are delivered via email before the retake day. There will be a deadline for orders listed on the top of the proof page. but you can order beyond that date if you pay a late fee. Senior portrait packages start at \$100; individual items may be ordered for less. I have investigated pricing at various school photography companies; BOPP is quite reasonable. Cap & gown proofs will be delivered around March.
